



Cross-Cultural Arts on the Eastrail

The Eastrail is a 42-mile trail corridor running from Renton to Snohomish, WA connecting five cities in two counties.

Eastrail Partners was formed in late 2019 as a nonprofit organization to unify the trail effort and bring community into the process.
